5	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide for additional
6	offenses that would allow a judge to deny bail under certain
7	circumstances.
8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
9	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
10	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

13	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
14	Section 16 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 16.
17	That all persons shall, before conviction, be bailable
18	by sufficient sureties, unless charged with capital murder, as
19	provided in Section 13A-5-40, Code of Alabama 1975, as
20	amended; murder, as provided in Section 13A-6-2, Code of
21	Alabama 1975, as amended, <u>or any solicitation, attempt, or</u>
22	conspiracy to commit murder; kidnapping in the first degree,
23	as provided in Section 13A-6-43, Code of Alabama 1975, as
24	amended; rape in the first degree, as provided in Section
25	13A-6-61, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; sodomy in the
26	first degree, as provided in Section 13A-6-63, Code of Alabama
27	1975, as amended; sexual torture, as provided in Section
28	13A-6-65.1, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; domestic



29 violence in the first degree, as provided in Section 30 13A-6-130, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; human trafficking 31 in the first degree, as provided in Section 13A-6-152, Code of 32 Alabama 1975, as amended; burglary in the first degree, as 33 provided in Section 13A-7-5, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; 34 arson in the first degree, as provided in Section 13A-7-41, 35 Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; robbery in the first degree, 36 as provided in Section 13A-8-41, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; terrorism, as provided in subdivision (b)(2) of 37 Section 13A-10-152, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; and 38 39 aggravated child abuse, as provided in subsection (b) of Section 26-15-3.1, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended; and 40 shooting or discharging a firearm, explosive, or other weapon 41 42 into an occupied dwelling, building, railroad locomotive, 43 railroad car, aircraft, automobile, truck, or watercraft, as provided in Section 13A-11-61(b); and that excessive 44 45 bail shall not in any case be required. 46

#### END OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

47 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 48 shall be held at the statewide primary election in 2026 in 49 accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of 50 Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this state. The 51 appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for 52 the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot 53 and shall set forth the following description of the substance 54 or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment: 55 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama

56 of 2022, to provide that the following offenses shall be



offenses for which a judge may deny bail: shooting or discharging a firearm into an occupied dwelling or other occupied space in violation of Section 13A-11-61(b), Code of Alabama 1975; or any solicitation, attempt, or conspiracy to commit murder.

66 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as 67 a part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved 68 by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
