1 *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventieth General Assembly*
2 *of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:*

4 (1) That, pursuant to the provision of section 2-2-305, Colorado

6 Regular Session of the Seventieth General Assembly with the monthly
7 compensation to be paid to the persons elected or appointed to each

30 *The Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of
31 Representatives are authorized to hire Legislative Aides pursuant to Joint
32 Rule 39 of the House of Representatives and the Senate. If Legislative
33 Aides are authorized by the Executive Committee, acting in accordance
34 with such Joint Rule 39, to start prior to the convening of the next regular
35 session, they may be paid at the rate specified in this resolution from the
36 date they are authorized to start.

37 (2) That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House

1 of Representatives remain in such capacity after adjournment of the
2 General Assembly *sine die* until the convening of the Second Regular
3 Session of the Seventieth General Assembly in January, 2016.

4 (3) That the Chairman of the Senate Services Committee, with the
5 authorization of the President, and the Chairman of the House Services
6 Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker, are hereby separately
7 authorized to retain and hire replacements for such employees for such
8 period of time in the interim between the First Regular Session of the
9 Seventieth General Assembly and the Second Regular Session of the
10 Seventieth General Assembly as they deem necessary for their respective
11 houses; except that the office equipment of the General Assembly and the
12 services of such employees shall be used only in connection with official
13 legislative business.

14 (4) That the Chairman of the Senate Services Committee, with the
15 authorization of the President, and the Chairman of the House Services
16 Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker, are hereby separately
17 authorized to hire such session-only employees for the next regular
18 session as they deem necessary for their respective houses and who may
19 start their employment on the date authorized.

20 (5) That the officers and the employees referred to in subsections (2)
21 through (4) of this resolution shall be compensated for their services at
22 the rate specified for such positions during the First Regular Session of
23 this Seventieth General Assembly, as may be modified by any salary
24 survey adjustments and merit increases to become effective during the
25 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, which are approved by the President
26 of the Senate for officers and employees of the Senate and the Speaker of
27 the House of Representatives for officers and employees of the House of
28 Representatives. All such compensation shall be paid from moneys
29 appropriated for such purposes by the Seventieth General Assembly.
