## "AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO VARIOUS STATUTES CONCERNING CRIMINAL JUSTICE."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
 internal references accordingly:

"Sec. 501. Section 46b-23 of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2025*):

5 (a) Any person who undertakes to join persons in marriage, knowing 6 that he is not authorized to do so, shall be fined not more than five 7 hundred dollars or imprisoned not more than one year or both.

8 (b) Any person who undertakes to join persons in marriage, knowing 9 that the persons seeking to be joined in marriage are doing so for the

10 purposes of evading any provision of federal immigration law shall be

- 11 guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 12 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) No person may marry another

13 person knowing that the marriage of such persons is for the purposes of

14	evading federal immigration law. Any person	who knowingly violates

- 15 the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 16 Sec. 503. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) No person shall solicit another
- 17 person to knowingly enter into a marriage for the purposes of evading
- 18 federal immigration law. Any person who violates the provisions of this
- 19 section shall be guilty of a class E felony."
