**"AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."**

1 Strike section 12 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 12. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2023, and applicable to taxable years  
4 commencing on or after January 1, 2023) There shall be allowed a credit  
5 against the tax imposed under chapter 229 of the general statutes, other  
6 than the liability imposed by section 12-707 of the general statutes, for  
7 the purchase of a gun safe that (1) is specifically manufactured to store  
8 firearms, (2) is constructed of steel or a material of equal or greater  
9 strength, (3) has a combination or key lock listed by Underwriters  
10 Laboratories, and (4) is for the personal, noncommercial use of the  
11 taxpayer. Such credit shall not exceed five hundred dollars and shall be  
12 claimed for the taxable year in which such safe was purchased. If the  
13 amount of such credit exceeds the taxpayer's liability for the tax  
14 imposed under chapter 229 of the general statutes, the excess shall not  
15 be refundable."
