"AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPARENCY IN EDUCATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (l) of section 10-145b of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*
5 *2023*):

6 (l) Upon application to the State Board of Education for the issuance
7 of any certificate in accordance with this section and section 10-145d,
8 [there shall be paid to the board by or on behalf of the applicant a
9 nonreturnable fee of two hundred dollars in the case of an applicant for
10 an initial educator certificate, two hundred fifty dollars in the case of an
11 applicant for a provisional educator certificate and three hundred

12 seventy-five dollars in the case of an applicant for a professional
 13 educator certificate, except that applicants for certificates for teaching
 14 adult education programs mandated under subparagraph (A) of
 15 subsection (a) of section 10-69 shall pay a fee of one hundred dollars;
 16 persons eligible for a certificate or endorsement for which the fee is less
 17 than that applied for shall receive an appropriate refund; persons not
 18 eligible for any certificate shall receive a refund of the application fee
 19 minus fifty dollars; and persons holding standard or permanent
 20 certificates on July 1, 1989, who apply for professional certificates to
 21 replace the standard or permanent certificates, shall not be required to
 22 pay such a fee. Upon application to the State Board of Education for the
 23 issuance of a subject area endorsement there shall be paid to the board
 24 by or on behalf of such applicant a nonreturnable fee of one hundred
 25 dollars. With each request for a duplicate copy of any such certificate or
 26 endorsement there shall be paid to the board a nonreturnable fee of fifty
 27 dollars] the State Board may charge to an applicant an application
 28 review fee in an amount not to exceed fifty dollars."
