- 1 Strike section 6 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
- 2 thereof:
- 3 "Sec. 6. Section 54-192h of the general statutes is amended by adding
- 4 subsection (h) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2025*):
- 5 (NEW) (h) A municipality may be subject to an action by any
- 6 aggrieved person for injunctive or declaratory relief, including a
- 7 determination of past violations, if an officer, employee or other person
- 8 otherwise paid by or acting as an agent of such municipality's police
- 9 department or of any school police or security department described in
- 10 subparagraph (B) or (C) of subdivision (11) of subsection (a) of this
- section for the school district of such municipality violates any provision
- of this section. Such action may be brought in the superior court for the
- 13 judicial district in which the municipality is located. If an aggrieved

14 person or municipality prevails in an action under this subsection, such

- aggrieved person or municipality may be entitled to recover court costs
- and reasonable attorney's fees associated only with an action or that
- portion of an action concerning a request and order for injunctive relief."
