**"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO VARIOUS STATUTES  
CONCERNING CRIMINAL JUSTICE."**

1 Strike section 6 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 6. Section 54-192h of the general statutes is amended by adding  
3 subsection (h) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

4 (NEW) (h) A municipality may be subject to an action by any  
5 aggrieved person for injunctive or declaratory relief, including a  
6 determination of past violations, if an officer, employee or other person  
7 otherwise paid by or acting as an agent of such municipality's police  
8 department or of any school police or security department described in  
9 subparagraph (B) or (C) of subdivision (11) of subsection (a) of this  
10 section for the school district of such municipality violates any provision  
11 of this section. Such action may be brought in the superior court for the  
12 judicial district in which the municipality is located. If an aggrieved  
13 person prevails in an action under this subsection and an order of

14 injunctive relief is issued, such aggrieved person may be entitled to  
15 recover court costs and reasonable attorney's fees associated only with  
16 an action or that portion of an action concerning a request and order for  
17 injunctive relief."
