## "AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO VARIOUS STATUTES CONCERNING CRIMINAL JUSTICE."

1 Strike section 6 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"Sec. 6. Section 54-192h of the general statutes is amended by adding
subsection (h) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

4 (NEW) (h) A municipality may be subject to an action by any aggrieved person for injunctive or declaratory relief, including a 5 determination of past violations, if an officer, employee or other person 6 7 otherwise paid by or acting as an agent of such municipality's police 8 department or of any school police or security department described in 9 subparagraph (B) or (C) of subdivision (11) of subsection (a) of this 10 section for the school district of such municipality violates any provision of this section. Such action may be brought in the superior court for the 11 12 judicial district in which the municipality is located. If an aggrieved 13 person prevails in an action under this subsection and an order of

- 17 injunctive relief."
