15 To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need
16 to provide for public safety enhancements in the District, and for other purposes.

18 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
19 resolution may be cited as the “Criminal Justice Coordinating Council Information Sharing
20 Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2024”.

21 Sec. 2. (a) On March 5, 2024, the Council passed the Criminal Justice Coordinating
22 Council Information Sharing Emergency Amendment Act of 2024, effective March 25, 2024 (D.C.
23 Act 25-424; 71 DCR 3517) (“emergency act”), which expires on June 23, 2024.

24 (b) On March 5, 2024, the Council also passed the Secure DC Omnibus Amendment Act
25 of 2024, enacted on March 11, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-411; 71 DCR 2732) (“permanent act”) which
26 has a projected law date of July 23, 2024 and includes the provisions in the emergency act.

27 (c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the
28 expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the permanent act.

29 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
30 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Criminal

32 Act of 2024 be adopted after a single reading.

33 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
