## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to carrying and possession of firearms, so as to require the issuance of
- 3 weapon carry license renewal notices; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 3 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to carrying and possession of firearms, is amended by adding a new subsection to
- 9 Code Section 16-11-129, relating to weapons carry license, gun safety information,
- 10 temporary renewal permit, mandamus, and verification of license, to read as follows:
- 11 "(a.2) Renewal notices.
- 12 (1) For each weapons carry license or renewal license issued on and after July 1, 2020,
- the judge of the probate court which issued such license, or his or her successor, shall
- provide notice to the person who holds such license of the expiration date of his or her
- 15 <u>license and information about current requirements and procedures for license renewal.</u>
- The form of such notice shall be as provided for by the Council of Probate Court Judges
- of Georgia. Such notice shall be sent not more than 90 days, but not fewer than 30 days,
- before the expiration date of such person's license and may be sent either electronically
- 19 to the electronic address or by first-class mail to the physical address, which appears on
- 20 <u>the application used for issuing such license.</u>
- 21 (2) The judge of the probate court's issuance or nonissuance of the notice provided for
- 22 <u>under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall have no effect upon the requirements of this</u>
- 23 <u>Code section."</u>
- SECTION 2.
- 25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
