3	→SECTION 1.	A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 237 IS CREATED TO

- 5 (1) A mandatory waiting period of five (5) business days shall be required between
- 6 the sale of a firearm and the transfer of the firearm to the buyer.
- 7 (2) Records of firearm sales shall be made available at all reasonable hours for
- 8 inspection by any peace officer acting within the scope of his or her duties.
- 9 (3) This section does not apply to a firearm transfer that does not require a
- 10 <u>background check under 18 U.S.C. sec. 922(t).</u>

- → Section 2. KRS 237.990 is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (1) Any person who violates any of the provisions of KRS 237.030 to 237.050 shall be guilty of a Class D felony.
- 14 (2) Any person who violates any of the provisions of KRS 237.030 to 237.050, and in
- so doing uses any destructive device or booby trap device to avoid detection by law
- enforcement or other government personnel or to avoid theft or detection by any
- other person, of any controlled substance as set forth in KRS Chapter 218A and
- held in violation of KRS 218A.140, shall be guilty of a Class C felony.
- 19 (3) Any person who violates Section 1 of this Act shall be guilty of a Class A
 20 misdemeanor.
