WEAPONS/HANDGUNS: Provides relative to the carrying of a concealed handgun at a parade or certain demonstrations

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1379.3(N)(9), relative to statewide permits for concealed
3 handguns; to provide relative to the carrying of a concealed handgun at a parade or
4 certain demonstrations; to require additional training for persons wishing to carry a
5 concealed handgun at a parade or certain demonstrations; and to provide for related
6 matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 40:1379.3(N)(9) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §1379.3. Statewide permits for concealed handguns; application procedures;
10 definitions

12 N. No concealed handgun may be carried into and no concealed handgun
13 permit issued pursuant to this Section shall authorize or entitle a permittee to carry
14 a concealed handgun in any of the following:

16 (9) A parade or demonstration for which a permit is issued by a
17 governmental entity, unless the permittee annually completes an eight-hour tactical
18 training in addition to the training requirements set forth in Subsection D of this
19 Section.

Abstract: Authorizes a concealed handgun permit holder to carry a concealed handgun at a parade or certain demonstrations, if the permit holder annually completes an additional eight-hour tactical training.

Present law provides for the issuance of a concealed handgun permit for a person who meets certain eligibility and training requirements.

Present law provides that a concealed handgun permit does not authorize or entitle the permit holder to carry a concealed handgun in certain places, including at a parade or demonstration for which a permit is issued by a governmental entity.

Proposed law amends present law to authorize a concealed handgun permit holder to carry a concealed handgun at a parade or demonstration for which a permit is issued by a governmental entity, if the permit holder annually completes an eight-hour tactical training in addition to the training requirements set forth in present law.
