# ACT No. 84

HOUSE BILL NO. 265

BY REPRESENTATIVE IVEY AND SENATORS ALARIO, AMEDEE, BUFFINGTON, CHABERT, CORTEZ, GALLOT, GUILLORY, MILLS, NEVERS, PERRY, RISER, GARY SMITH, JOHN SMITH, THOMPSON, WARD, AND WHITE

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

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AN ACT

To enact R.S. 40:1379.3(V), relative to concealed handgun permits; to provide for the issuance of a lifetime concealed handgun permit; to provide for criteria for the issuance of the permit; to provide for revocation of the permit; to require prepayment of fees; to provide for applicability; to provide for suspension of the permit under certain conditions; to provide for the educational training requirements for the issuance of a lifetime concealed handgun permit; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 40:1379.3(V) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1379.3. Statewide permits for concealed handguns; application procedures; definitions

\* \* \*

V.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a Louisiana resident who meets the provisions of this Section may be issued a lifetime concealed handgun permit. The term for the lifetime concealed handgun permit shall be for the life of the permit holder.

(2) A person issued a lifetime concealed handgun permit shall be required to meet the qualifications and competency requirements for the issuance of a concealed handgun permit pursuant to the provisions of Subsections C and D of this Section.

(3) A person issued a lifetime concealed handgun permit shall have a continuing obligation to comply with the provisions of this Section and any other rules or provisions of law regarding the carrying of concealed handguns.

1                   (4)(a) A lifetime concealed handgun permit holder shall provide the division  
2                   with proof of completion of educational training every five years. The educational  
3                   training shall include all of the following:

4                   (i) Instruction on handgun nomenclature and safe handling procedures for  
5                   a revolver and a semiautomatic pistol.

6                   (ii) Instruction on ammunition knowledge and fundamentals of pistol  
7                   shooting.

8                   (iii) Instruction on handgun shooting positions.

9                   (iv) Instruction on the use of deadly force and conflict resolution which shall  
10                  include a review of R.S. 14:18 through 22 and which may include a review of any  
11                  other laws relating to use of deadly force.

12                  (v) Instruction on child access prevention.

13                  (vi) Actual live range fire and proper handgun cleaning procedures:

14                  (aa) Live range fire shall include twelve rounds each at six feet, ten feet, and  
15                  fifteen feet for a total of thirty-six rounds.

16                  (bb) Each applicant or permittee must perform at least one safe reload of the  
17                  handgun at each distance.

18                  (cc) Each applicant or permittee must score one hundred percent hits within  
19                  the silhouette portion of a N.R.A. B-27 type silhouette target with at least thirty-six  
20                  rounds.

21                  (b) Failure to submit proof of completion of the educational training pursuant  
22                  to the provisions of this Paragraph shall result in the suspension of the lifetime  
23                  concealed handgun permit until such time as the lifetime concealed handgun permit  
24                  holder submits proof of the educational training required in the provisions of this  
25                  Paragraph.

26                  (5) The deputy secretary of the department shall revoke the lifetime  
27                  concealed handgun permit if the permittee fails to satisfy the qualifications and  
28                  requirements of Subsection C of this Section or violates the provisions of Subsection  
29                  I of this Section.

1           (6) A lifetime concealed handgun permit shall be suspended if the holder of  
 2           that permit becomes a resident of another state. The lifetime concealed handgun  
 3           permit shall be reactivated upon reestablishment of residency in Louisiana if the  
 4           applicant otherwise meets the requirements of this Section and upon successful  
 5           completion of a criminal history records check.

6           (7) An applicant for a lifetime concealed handgun permit shall pay the yearly  
 7           fee provided for in Paragraph (H)(2) of this Section but shall prepay that fee for a  
 8           total of twenty years at the time the application is made. If the applicant is sixty-five  
 9           years of age or older, he shall pay the yearly fee provided for in Paragraph (H)(2) of  
 10          this Section but shall prepay that fee for a total of ten years at the time the  
 11          application is made.
