**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to the use of the Neponset Valley Parkway in the town of Milton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           No person shall operate a truck, bus, camper, trailer, semi-trailer unit, mobile home or  
2 any vehicle with a seating capacity of more than 12 persons on the Neponset Valley Parkway in  
3 the Town of Milton, a roadway under the control of the department of conservation and  
4 recreation within the urban parks district; provided, however, that a school bus and pickup truck  
5 or van having a gross vehicle weight of 5,000 pounds or less and a maximum overall height of 7  
6 feet or less shall be permitted. Prohibited vehicles may access Neponset Valley Parkway only to  
7 abutting residential homes and healthcare facilities located on the roadway and only with the  
8 express consent of the department of conservation and recreation. A violation of this act shall be  
9 punished by a fine of not less than \$100 not more than \$500.
