**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to the Civilian Marksmanship Program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 123 of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting a new paragraph:

3 "Notwithstanding any general law, special law, or regulation to the contrary, firearms
4 furnished through the Civilian Marksmanship Program as established by the United States
5 Congress shall be eligible for transfer by a licensee."
