8 An Act relating to firearms; amending 63 O.S. 2021,
9 Section 4210.3, which relates to the Oklahoma Boating
10 Safety Regulation Act; modifying scope of certain
11 unlawful act; removing mandatory minimum penalties;
12 deleting provision concerning the transport of
13 handguns by licensees; and providing an effective
14 date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 4210.3, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 4210.3 It shall be unlawful to ~~transport a shotgun,~~
18 ~~rifle or pistol in or to discharge such weapons~~ a firearm from a
19 vessel, except for the purposes of self-defense, hunting animals or
20 fowl, and in compliance with existing state and federal laws.

21 Anyone violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction,
22 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of
23 not ~~less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not~~ more than One Hundred
24 Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not

1 ~~less than ten (10) days and not more than six (6) three (3) months,~~
2 ~~or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person in possession of~~
3 ~~a valid handgun license from this state or a reciprocal state~~
4 ~~authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not be deemed~~
5 ~~guilty of transporting a pistol in violation of this section when a~~
6 ~~handgun is carried concealed or unconcealed upon or about their~~
7 ~~person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-~~
8 ~~Defense Act.~~

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
