12 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 185, O.S.L.
14 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 840-2.10a), is amended to read as
15 follows:

16 Section 840-2.10a A. ~~The following state~~ State agencies shall
17 provide or contract to provide, through the State Employee
18 Assistance Program, debriefing and counseling services for state
19 employees who are ~~affected by violent or~~ involved in, witness or are
20 otherwise exposed to traumatic events that occur in the workplace:

21 ~~1. The Department of Human Services;~~

22 ~~2. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse~~
23 ~~Services;~~

24 ~~3. The Department of Corrections;~~

1 4. ~~The Department of Transportation; and~~

2 5. ~~The Office of Juvenile Affairs.~~

3 B. State employees who are affected by ~~violent or traumatic~~
4 ~~events that occur in the workplace~~ such events shall be encouraged
5 to participate in debriefing or counseling services, and paid
6 administrative leave shall be provided **for attendance at such**
7 **debriefings and counseling sessions;** however, employees shall have
8 the option to refuse the ~~debriefing and counseling~~ services offered
9 ~~pursuant to subsection A of this section.~~

10 C. The Director of the Office of ~~State Finance~~ Management and
11 Enterprise Services shall promulgate rules to implement the
12 provisions of this section which, at a minimum, shall specify the
13 types of events which shall qualify state employees for debriefing
14 and counseling services.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
