7 An Act relating to schools; requiring school
8 districts to undergo certain assessment by certain
9 date; requiring the assessment to include certain
10 recommendations; providing certain exemption;
11 directing school districts in certain coordination to
12 conduct re-assessments; providing for codification;
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-148.1 of Title 70, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Except as provided for in subsection B of this section, by
20 July 1, 2026, each school district in this state shall undergo a
21 risk and vulnerability assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School
22 Security Institute. The assessment shall include recommendations to
23 increase security on school district property.

24 B. A school district that underwent a risk and vulnerability
assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School Security Institute in

1 the two (2) years prior to the effective date of this act shall be
2 exempt from the provisions of subsection A of this section.

3 C. After an initial risk and vulnerability assessment is
4 conducted, school districts shall coordinate with the Oklahoma
5 School Security Institute to conduct re-assessments every five (5)
6 years.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
