

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3455

By COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “390.560 and”.
- 2 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
- 3 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 390.565 is amended to read:
- 4 “390.565. (1) The All-Terrain Vehicle Advisory Committee is established. The committee shall
- 5 consist of [14] **16** voting members and one nonvoting member appointed by the State Parks and Re-
- 6 creation Commission for a term of four years. Members are eligible for reappointment and vacancies
- 7 may be filled by the commission. A majority of members constitutes a quorum for the transaction
- 8 of business.
- 9 “(2) Of the voting members of the committee:
- 10 “(a) One shall be a representative of a Class I all-terrain vehicle user organization.
- 11 “(b) One shall be a representative of a Class II all-terrain vehicle user organization.
- 12 “(c) One shall be a representative of a Class III all-terrain vehicle user organization.
- 13 “(d) One shall be a representative of a Class IV all-terrain vehicle user organization.
- 14 “(e) One shall be an all-terrain vehicle dealer.
- 15 “(f) One shall be an at-large all-terrain vehicle user.
- 16 “(g) One shall be a representative of the United States Forest Service who is knowledgeable
- 17 about all-terrain vehicle recreation areas on federal lands.
- 18 “(h) One shall be a representative of the Bureau of Land Management who is knowledgeable
- 19 about all-terrain vehicle recreation areas on federal lands.
- 20 “(i) One shall be a representative of the Department of Transportation who is knowledgeable
- 21 about transportation safety.
- 22 “(j) One shall be a representative of the State Forestry Department who is knowledgeable about
- 23 all-terrain vehicle recreation areas on state lands.
- 24 “(k) One shall be a representative of the Department of Human Services who is knowledgeable
- 25 about public health and safety.
- 26 “(L) One shall be a representative of a law enforcement agency who is knowledgeable about and
- 27 active in enforcement of all-terrain vehicle laws.
- 28 “(m) One shall be a representative of the State Department of Fish and Wildlife who is know-
- 29 ledgeable about all-terrain vehicle activities and the use of all-terrain vehicles in hunting and fish-
- 30 ing.
- 31 “(n) One shall be a person who represents persons with disabilities.
- 32 “(o) **One shall be a representative of a rural fire protection district.**
- 33 “(p) **One shall be a representative of emergency medical services providers.**
- 34 “(3) One representative from the State Parks and Recreation Department shall be a nonvoting
- 35 member of the committee.

1 “(4) The committee shall:
2 “(a) Review accidents and fatalities resulting from all-terrain vehicle recreation and make rec-
3 ommendations to the State Parks and Recreation Commission.
4 “(b) Review changes to statutory vehicle classifications as necessary for safety considerations
5 and make recommendations to the commission.
6 “(c) Review safety features of all classes of off-highway vehicles and make recommendations to
7 the commission.
8 “(d) Recommend appropriate safety requirements to protect child operators and riders of off-
9 highway vehicles to the commission.
10 “(5)(a) A subcommittee of the All-Terrain Vehicle Advisory Committee, titled the All-Terrain
11 Vehicle Grant Subcommittee, [*shall be established consisting of the following members:*] **is estab-**
12 **lished.**
13 **“(b) The All-Terrain Vehicle Grant Subcommittee shall consist of the following members:**
14 “(A) The representative of a Class I all-terrain vehicle user organization.
15 “(B) The representative of a Class II all-terrain vehicle user organization.
16 “(C) The representative of a Class III all-terrain vehicle user organization.
17 “(D) The representative of a Class IV all-terrain vehicle user organization.
18 “(E) The at-large all-terrain vehicle user.
19 “(F) The representative of a law enforcement agency.
20 “(G) The representative of persons with disabilities.
21 “[(b)] (c) The All-Terrain Vehicle Grant Subcommittee shall:
22 “(A) Advise the State Parks and Recreation Department on the allocation of moneys in the
23 All-Terrain Vehicle Account established by ORS 390.555; and
24 “(B) Review grant proposals and make recommendations to the commission as to which projects
25 should receive grant funding.
26 “[(c)] (d) Recommendations [*under this subsection*] on grant proposals **under this subsection**
27 must receive an affirmative vote from at least four of the members of the **grant** subcommittee.
28 **“(6) The State Parks and Recreation Department shall establish and operate an outreach**
29 **program to inform law enforcement agencies, rural fire protection districts and emergency**
30 **medical services providers about the grant process and the grant opportunities available**
31 **under this section and to provide clarification and answer questions about the grant appli-**
32 **cation process.**
33 “[(6)] (7) The State Parks and Recreation Department shall provide staff support for the com-
34 mittee and shall provide for expansion of programs for all-terrain vehicle users.”.
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
