1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the crime of rustling to include sheep and goats.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That section 60 of SB 70 as previously enacted by the Eighty-Eighth Legislature
4 be amended to read as follows:

5 Section 60. That § 22-30A-17 be amended to read as follows:

6 22-30A-17. Grand theft is a Class 6 felony, if the property stolen:

- 7 (1) Exceeds one thousand dollars in value but is less than or equal to two thousand five
8 hundred dollars;
- 9 (2) Is a firearm with a value of less than or equal to two thousand five hundred dollars;
- 10 (3) Is taken from the person of another with a value of less than or equal to two thousand
11 five hundred dollars; or
- 12 (4) The property stolen is cattle, horses, mules, sheep, goats, buffalo, or captive
13 nondomestic elk with a value of less than or equal to two thousand five hundred
14 dollars.



1 Grand theft is a Class 5 felony if the value of the property is more than two thousand five
2 hundred dollars but less than or equal to five thousand dollars.

3 Grand theft is a Class 4 felony if the value of the property is more than five thousand dollars
4 but less than or equal to one hundred thousand dollars.

5 Grand theft is a Class 3 felony if the value of the property is more than one hundred
6 thousand dollars but less than or equal to five hundred thousand dollars.
