## A BILL

To promote the tracing of firearms used in crimes, and  
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Crime Gun Tracing  
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

7 Section 1709 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe  
8 Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796dd–8) is amended  
9 by—

10 (1) redesignating paragraphs (1) through (4) as  
11 paragraphs (2) through (5), respectively; and



1 **SEC. 4. REPORTING OF FIREARM TRACING BY APPLICANTS**  
2 **FOR COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERV-**  
3 **ICES GRANTS.**

4 Section 1702(e) of the Omnibus Crime Control and  
5 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796dd–1(e)) is  
6 amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (10), by striking “and” at the  
8 end;

9 (2) in paragraph (11), by striking the period at  
10 the end and inserting “; and”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(12) specify—

13 “(A) whether the applicant recovered any  
14 firearms at a crime scene or during the course  
15 of a criminal investigation during the 12  
16 months before the submission of the applica-  
17 tion;

18 “(B) the number of firearms described in  
19 subparagraph (A);

20 “(C) the number of firearms described in  
21 subparagraph (A) that were reported to the Bu-  
22 reau for tracing, or to a State agency that re-  
23 ports such firearms to the Bureau for tracing;  
24 and

25 “(D) the reason why any firearms de-  
26 scribed under subparagraph (A) were not re-

1           ported to the Bureau for tracing, or to a State  
2           agency that reports such firearms to the Bu-  
3           reau for tracing.”.
