2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That upon a request by the Attorney General to the Com-
4 missioner of Social Security to furnish information pursu-
5 ant to section 103(e)(1) of the Brady Handgun Violence
6 Prevention Act, the Commissioner of Social Security may
7 not furnish the name of any individual entitled to benefits

1 under title II of the Social Security Act, including any in-
2 dividual whose benefits are paid to a representative payee
3 under section 205(j) of such Act, unless a Federal court
4 has determined the individual to be mentally defective.
