A BILL

To repeal the Gun-Free School Zones Act of 1990 and amendments to that Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safe Students Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF THE GUN-FREE SCHOOL ZONES ACT OF**
6 **1990 AND AMENDMENTS TO THAT ACT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922 of title 18, United
8 States Code, is amended by striking subsection (q).

1 (b) RELATED AMENDMENTS.—

2 (1) Section 921(a) of such title is amended by
3 striking paragraphs (25) through (27) and redesignating
4 paragraphs (28), (29), and (32) through (35)
5 as paragraphs (25) through (30), respectively.

6 (2) Section 924(a) of such title is amended—

7 (A) in paragraph (1)(B), by striking “(k),
8 or (q)” and inserting “or (k)”; and

9 (B) by striking paragraph (4) and redesignating
10 paragraphs (5) through (7) as paragraphs
11 (4) through (6), respectively.

12 (3) The Gun-Free School Zones Act of 1990
13 (18 U.S.C. 921 note, 922 note; section 1702 of Public
14 Law 101–647; 104 Stat. 4844–4845) is repealed.
