## 2017 SENATE BILL 17

February 2, 2017 - Introduced by Senators CARPENTER, C. LARSON and RISSER, cosponsored by Representatives C. TAYLOR, BERCEAU, HEBL, SARGENT, SUBECK, WACHS and SINICKI. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 941.29 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** purchasing or  
2           possessing a firearm for a person who is prohibited from possessing a firearm  
3           and providing a criminal penalty.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, a person who furnishes with a firearm a person who is prohibited from possessing a firearm may be convicted of illegally possessing a firearm, a Class G felony. This bill adds that a person who purchases or intentionally possesses a firearm for a person who is prohibited from possessing a firearm may be convicted of illegally possessing a firearm.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4           **SECTION 1.** 941.29 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5           941.29 (4) A person is concerned with the commission of a crime, as specified
